2 Structure

The configuration for the default implementation is:

```

  <royal-mail-cbc>
    <module-width>{length:0.53mm}</module-width>
    <track-height>{length:1.25mm}</track-height>
    <ascender-height>{length:1.25mm}</ascender-height>
    <interchar-gap-width>{length:1mw}</interchar-gap-width>
    <quiet-zone enabled="{boolean:true}">{length:10mw}</quiet-zone>
    <checksum>{checksum-mode:auto=add}</checksum>
  </royal-mail-cbc>
</barcode>
```

3 Notes

- This symbology has no human-readable part!

4 Message format

- Valid characters are 0-9 and A-Z
- Start and stop characters are: ([]) (they are added automatically as necessary)
